## Piedmont Valley Library Non-Resident User Fee Policy Effective February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Anyone living in Meade County may apply for a free library card. Verification of current address within Meade County (i.e. Driver's license, utility or phone bill) will be required to create a library account.

Children under 18 must have their account created by a parent or legal guardian in person and the account must have an attached adult guarantor account.

Persons living outside of Meade County may obtain an individual card for \$15.00 per year or a family library card for \$25.00 per year. A family card is defined by all members residing at the same address who will be authorized to borrow materials from the Piedmont Valley Library. Due to contractual obligations, persons paying for a non-resident card may not be provided access to Overdrive/Libby under the Piedmont Valley Library. Non-Meade County members may be directed to the State Library or the library for that person's legal service area for Overdrive/Libby Access.

All current staff members of the Meade County School District may apply for a free individual library card. The non-resident fee is waived for staff members who reside outside of Meade County, renewable annually as long as employed by the Meade County School District.
